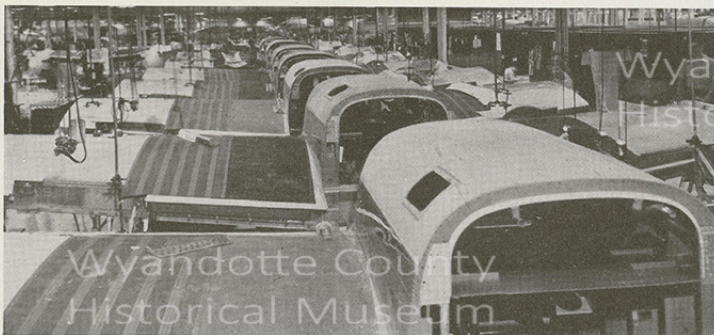


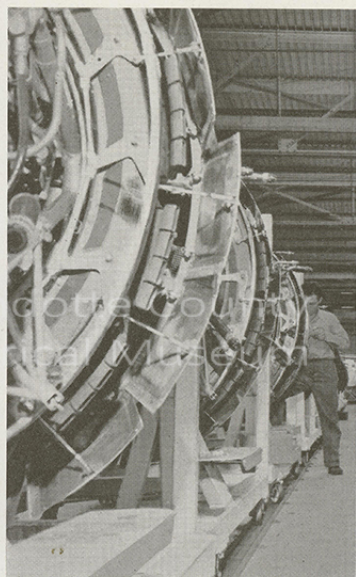
# KANSAS Keeps Them Coming
