
KCKPL eCard: Get immediate access to KCKPL eContent

If you already have a personal Kansas City, KS Public Library card, you're already a member and don't need to sign up for an eCard.

To sign up for an eCard:

- 1. Go to KCKPL eCommunity located at https://ecommunity.kckpl.org/
- 2. Select the "Get a Card" box located in the top right-hand corner



3. You will be redirected to the following page where you can input your information. (Note: You may input your birth date in the following format, with slashes: MM/DD/YYY or MM/DD/YY). Choose your own pin, minimum 4 digits. Click "Register."
